This letter shall serve as recognition for the subcontracting work that your company, AdaRose Inc., has performed for Northrop Grumman Mission Systems (NGMS) over the past five years. AdaRose has satisfied 10 separate task orders over this contractual period. The AdaRose and NGMS Team efforts have resulted in major improvements to the Army's Paladin Artillery weapon system, e.g.,

- Replacement of obsolete hardware by a software solution resulting in cost savings, reduced maintenance and improved gun pointing accuracy
- New autonomous windowing display system that allows the primary mission-critical program to continue to be operational if another program fails
- Enhanced Built-In-Test (BIT) for improved system fault isolation
- More accurate & reliable muzzle velocity and prognostic/diagnostic systems
- Dedicated software device drivers that allow new HW devices to be added easily

Most notable was the successful development and fielding of Paladin's new artillery digital fire control system for the Soldier. To date, there have been no reported field problems since the deployment of this new system -- a tribute to the outstanding job by all members of the NGMS and AdaRose Team.

Our most recent collaborative project was the development of a new Graphical User Interface (GUI) for Paladin. This demonstration version of software was overwhelmingly appreciated by the New Equipment Training Team (NETT) personnel at Fort Sill, OK.
